Job Description

Qualifications & Requirements

- Be a servant-leader
- Embrace the role of being **the** unseen hands and feet for these campers
- Accept responsibility for the safety of campers & staffers
- Uphold integrity especially when not directly supervised
- Must be at minimum, a Junior in High School & 16 years or older
- Must be able to work 2+ camps (4 camps is preferred)
- Must be willing to complete Lifeguard Training & Certification

Chain of Communication

- Report directly to Director of Camping (DOC)
- Maintain uplifting rapport with other Safety Task Force members (Ephesians 4:29)

Pre-camp Responsibilities

- Complete and turn in Youth Protection Training and W9 forms to Hospitality Director
- Prepare yourself spiritually, mentally, and physically prior to coming out to camp
- Talk through job description with Staffing Director AND DOC
- Make yourself very familiar with Still Water's COVID-19 Preventive Measures
- Attend & complete Lifeguard Training
- Arrive at camp no later than 4pm on Staff arrival day
 - (If arriving later prior arrangements need to be made with DOC AND Camp Director)
- Attend Safety Task Force prep meeting with DOC the day before camp
- Lead any cleaning & sanitizing procedures necessary prior to Camper Arrival
- Get to know your Safety Task Force team members & other staff

Camp Responsibilities

- Attend and participate in Staff Morning Devos
- Help check temperatures & collect signed health screening forms during Camper Arrival
- Man doorways & entrances to dining areas, worship buildings, & large group gatherings
- Perform extra daily cleaning & sanitation sweep of camp buildings
- Carry out multiple common surface sanitations regularly throughout each day
- Prep & sanitize Waterfront area & equipment daily or between each swimming group
- Oversee all Waterfront activities, including Swim Tests, and ensure campers & staff follow Waterfront rules to keep everyone safe
- Help with temperature checks & exit health screenings for Camper Dismissal
